



KIWANIS CLUB OF TORONTO FOUNDATION (the “Foundation”)

COMMUNITY ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Parameters governing applications:

1. The application for the Award should support an extraordinary project or projects designed primarily to improve the quality of life of the underprivileged children and youth of the Toronto community served by the Foundation. Preference will be given to projects which are viewed by the Award adjudicators as demonstrating the potential for significant impact on the community.
2. The catchment area in question is represented by the community governed by the boundaries of the old City of Toronto. The group applying for the Award should be working primarily within this catchment area.
3. The Award will be for capital and operating expenditures associated with a specific project proposal, with the capital expenditure allocation in priority. It is not designed to support the general operating requirements of the applicant.
4. The group applying for the Award must be a not-for-profit organization with a registered charitable number. It must be able to provide at least three years of financial statements, a current operating budget, and other information as outlined in the application.
5. The group applying for the Award should not be a provincial, national or international agency or service club, and should not be in receipt of major corporate, civic, and provincial and federal governmental sources of funding. It is anticipated that the group's annual revenues will not exceed \$10 million.
6. Applications for the Award must be made directly by the groups interested in applying, and not by outside parties or agents engaged by them.
7. The Award will be for a single year. It is not designed to support a multi-year project initiative.
8. Any application for the Award must be received by the Foundation by May 2, 2011 at the address shown in the application. Submissions received after this date cannot be considered. Receipt of all applications will be acknowledged.
9. Applications for the Award will be adjudicated by a panel selected by the Foundation. The decision of the Foundation is final and cannot be appealed. Presentation of the Award will be made at a suitable event to be announced. The Foundation reserves the right to publicize/promote the Award at its discretion.
10. The group that wins this Award may not apply again for a minimum period of five years after winning it.
